Academic Programs:

Honor Academy

The Honor Academy at Living Word is a unique curricular concept designed for students who desire academic rigor and the opportunity to pursue their passions in a particular academic area. Opportunities for students to personalize the Academy to fit their passions allow students to thrive.

Dual Credit Programs

Living Word partners with Grand Canyon University (online classes) and Concordia University Wisconsin (online & on-campus classes), and UW-Oshkosh (CAAP program) to provide courses that students may take for dual high school and college credit.

Resource (Academic Success)

Resource Study Hall is a class designed to reinforce concepts that are taught in the classroom and give them extra time and resources to succeed. This is available for students with IEPs or service/accommodation plans.

Winterim

Each year in January, students take a three-week intensive course of their choice, before the start of the second semester. Courses vary from year to year. Every class offers an interactive, hands-on learning environment, both inside and outside the classroom, with field trips and projects
